

In the Netherlands, trackday-events can be organised if the organisation can guarantee:

- People are fully vaccinated, or
- People are tested negative recently, or
- People recovered from Covid-19.

This counts for organisation and riders, but also for spectators, sponsors etc. This means that, after this check, all other restrictions (1,5 meter distance, masks, amount of people on the paddock, list with names etc.) will expire. So you don't have to provide a list anymore and riders can bring their family and friends.

In the Netherlands we have a mobile app, called 'Corona check app', provided by the government. With this app people can upload one of the three documents mentioned above. For our people at the gates, this makes it a lot easier to check, together with an ID.

If people don't have an app or a smart phone, a paper proof could also work (always in combination with an ID).

We also accept the German Corona Warn App, as long it can show the documents requested.

If someone can not show 1 of the requested documents, it is by Dutch law not accepted to enter the location.
